MESSAGE

It gives me immense pleasure to present Annual Report of Punjab Education Initiatives Management Authority. PEIMA is committed to strengthening the existing assets and introducing new initiatives to bring quality education at no cost to students.

PEIMA has exhibited progress in ensuring access to quality education in the remote areas of Punjab through public private partnership framework. This framework has successfully evolved over the years and has produced and nourished human resources. PEIMA students, teachers, partners, communities and other stakeholders are on track to achieve the goals set by Govt. of Punjab.

In order to improve efficiency and transparency PEIMA got its own SIS developed. This has enabled PEIMA and its partners to timely enrol students and monitor their performance as well as real time data of school infrastructure and allied matters.

During the year enrolment of students increased to more than six Lac. More than Eight Thousand additional classrooms have been constructed at no cost to Government, **4000** teachers have been trained, QAT of more than sixty thousand students has been carried out under which **81.16%** of students passed whereas **85%** of schools passed as per the standards set through notified criteria. Similarly Punjab Examination Commission (PEC) carried out Large Scale Assessment of various types of school in the province in which results of PEIMA schools were comparable with PEF, DPS and LNFBE.

These achievements are noteworthy in view of the fact that PEIMA Schools are the schools which were non-functional under SED. These schools were handed over to PEIMA which out sourced them to private individuals and organizations under Public Private Partnership framework. The Licensees of PEIMA through using local human resource and innovative management techniques have succeeded where others have struggled.

PEIMA aims to continue working towards building an educated Punjab by providing quality education through Public Private Partnership. It commits to further improve its performance under the guidance of its Board.

DETAILS OF AUTHORITY MEETINGS

In the Financial Year 2022-2023, four meetings of Authority were held.

16TH AUTHORITY MEETING

The 16th meeting of PEIMA was held on 06-07-2022 under the Chairmanship of Sahibzada M. Gazain Abbasi, (ex-MPA). Ms. Amtul Qadoos, Chief Executive Officer briefed that PEIMA is continuously striving to achieve its mission. For this purpose, modalities of the Punjab Learning Acceleration Program in PEIMA schools along-with additional budget demands were presented before the Authority members.

It was approved that PEIMA management may start process of tendering for out-sourcing recruitment of support staff and security personnel.

17TH AUTHORITY MEETING

17th meeting of PEIMA was held on 19-8-2022. The meeting was chaired by Sahibzada M. Gazain Abbasi, Chairperson. Chief Executive Officer welcomed participants and presented the agenda items. Enhancement of subsidy rate at primary and elementary level was discussed and approved.

18TH AUTHORITY MEETING

The 18th Authority meeting was held on 14-01-2023 under the Chairpersonship of Sahibzada M. Gazain Abbasi. Ms. Safina Siddique, Chief Executive Officer welcomed the participants. She acknowledged efforts of PEIMA licensees and PEIMA for introducing initiatives so that licensees are encouraged in providing improved services in education sector.

The CEO presented agenda items that included revision of criteria of kinship category, as well as revised budget 2022-23 as per allocation/release by Finance Department.

The Authority approved minutes of 17th Authority meeting along-with minutes of 8th & 9th Program Committee, 7th HR Committee, 1st, 2nd & 3rd Monitoring Committees, and 1st Audit Committee meetings.

19TH AUTHORITY MEETING

The 19th Authority meeting was held under the Chairpersonship of Dr. Nasir Mahmood on 19-05-2023. Chief Executive Officer welcomed the Chairperson. Who appreciated efforts of PEIMA in promotion of education in remote and far-flung areas of Punjab. He acknowledged contributions of PEIMA licensees for promotion of education. The Authority re-constituted its Committees due to change in its members.

The CEO presented other agenda items including Outsourcing of low performing public schools under PPP mode, Teachers' Training 2023 and Penalty Framework. After extensive discussion, the same were approved.

DETAILS OF COMMITTEE MEETINGS

MEETINGS OF HR COMMITTEE

The HR Committee held its 7th & 8th meetings on 19-12-2022 and 09-06-2023 respectively to review business processes and provision of support to operations of the Authority. These included appointment of temporary staff, rationalization of posts, and discussion on PEIMA rules & regulations.

MEETINGS OF PROGRAM COMMITTEE

During the Financial year 2022-2023, Six Meetings of Program Committee were held. Mechanism for the setting of Upper-Cap, Revision of Mechanism for Reallocation Criteria of PEIMA Schools, Extension in License Agreement in future, Advertisement for Reallocation of 533 PSSP-PEIMA schools, Development of SOPs for closed and non-visited schools was decided. 283 PEIMA Schools were recommended to be upgraded from Primary to Elementary Level, Approval of Draft Agreement for development of School Information System with PITB, Conduction of Physical Verification of Students enrolled in PEIMA-PSSP schools through Assistant Education Officers (DEA)/ Focal Person, Reallocation policy, Teachers Training 2023, Passing criteria for Quality Assurance Test (QAT) 2023 were discussed during the meetings.

MEETINGS OF FINANCE COMMITTEE

Four meetings of Finance Committee were held under the convenorship of Mr. Haider Bajwa on 05-07-2022, 18-10-2022, 18-01-2023 and 26-05-2023.

The Agenda items discussed in the Finance Committee meetings are as under:

- a) Budget Utilization of Financial Year 2021-22.
- b) Training of Teachers by QAED of 1596 schools.
- c) Investment of funds.
- d) Approval of Incentive allowance.
- e) Budget Estimates for Financial Year 2023-24.



UPGRADATION FROM PRIMARY TO ELEMENTARY LEVEL

In academic session 2022-23, 283 schools have been granted provisional permission for admission in Elementary level classes subject to certain conditions.

MECHANISM FOR QUANTIFICATION CRITERIA FOR RE-ALLOCATION

PEIMA Authority approved the Re-allocation criteria.

KINSHIP CRITERIA

Earlier in Kinship policy only Husband or Children of the deceased licensee were entitled to get benefit of license agreement. Parents and siblings have now been allowed to apply for reallocation of license subject to certain conditions.

INCREASE IN SUBSIDY RATE

PEIMA sanctioned enhancement in monthly rate of subsidy per student for primary and elementary level w.e.f. 1st September 2022 as under:

To enhance the mental and physical health of students sports activities play a vital role. PEIMA issued sports activities calendar in PEIMA Schools.


ACADEMIC CALENDAR



- ii. Thrice failure in Quality Assurance Test.



MONITORING REGIME

There are four tiers of monitoring for PEIMA schools:

- I) Third Party Monitoring through Program Monitoring and Implementation Unit (PMIU). PMIU issues schedule of MEA visits. MEA uses monitoring app installed in tablet provided by PMIU in which data of PSSP-PEIMA Schools is already fed. MEA pay surprise visit to the school and verify the data of infrastructure, physical attendance of staff and students and facilities in the school.
- ii) Physical verification through AEOs of District Education Authorities.
- iii) Monitoring Visits/ Special Visits by PEIMA staff.
- iv) E-Monitoring through video calls. It has been introduced for checking of infrastructure enrolment and functionality of schools at zero cost.







BUDGET

During FY 2022-23, 97% of total budget was allocated for Program cost. PEIMA released monthly payment to schools based on enrolment as per following policy approved by the Authority:

“Payment is calculated on the basis of lowest enrolment / attendance from amongst the following data:

- i. *Upper cap limit revised time to time.*
- ii. *PMIU monthly monitoring report.*
- iii. *Monthly update by the licensee*
- iv. *Student information System data”*

QUALITY ASSURANCE TEST (QAT)

Quality Assurance Test (QAT) is a broad tool to assess the students learning, as well as the impact of PEIMA-PSSP initiative on the education system. The QAT helps to:

- i. Gauge the progress on quality and standard of education.
- ii. Ranking of educational institutions based on educational standards.
- iii. Channelize efforts of private sector in providing quality education and improving service delivery.

PEIMA has got conducted QAT in past as under:

PEIMA conducted QAT from 04th July 2023 till 23rd July 2023 for students of 4 classes (Grade 3, 4, 5 & 6) in four subjects (Urdu, English, Mathematics & Science/ General Knowledge).

Salient features of QAT are as under:

- i. Standardized MCQs and CRQs based assessment items
- ii. Digital variable printing
- iii. Sample based
- iv. On Screen Marking
- v. Dissemination of results to stakeholders/Licensees
- vi. Asses Literacy, Numeracy, and Science skills

ITEM DEVELOPMENT AND PILOTING

Subject Specialists for item writing and training workshops were arranged. A pool of items was developed on Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) with different difficulty levels, and cognitive skills, along with rubrics and key solutions. Items efficacy was determined through Pilot Testing where students of 184 schools were selected from 23 Districts covering all Divisions of Punjab which is 5% of the entire population. The final items were shortlisted for QAT based on item analysis of pilot testing.

DEVELOPMENT OF ASSESSMENT TOOLS

The QAT consisted of Constructed Response Questions (CRQs) and Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) for assessment of Literacy, Numeracy (Mathematics) & Scientific skills of the students.


DIGITAL PRINTING

SAMPLING

It was decided to conduct sample based QAT instead of population base. A representative sample of 6 students from each Grade (3,4,5 & 6) was randomly selected by PEIMA from each school to participate in QAT.

ASSESSMENT CENTERS & CONDUCT

PEIMA established 749 examination centers for 3723 schools across the province. Test Administrators were engaged to ensure efficient and transparent conduct of exams from 01st March 2023 till 04th March 2023. Total **61985** students were selected to appear in the exams.







MONITORING OF CONDUCT OF QAT








ON SCREEN MARKING

Marking was made through On Screen Marking system. All answer booklets were scanned through state-of-the-art scanners. Bubble sheets involved in MCQs were marked in digital and computerized automatic system. 756 Government School Teachers as Subject Specialists were engaged in the “On Screen Marking” of student responses of CRQs. To further ensure the quality of e-marking, the Aggregate Marking Difference of all e-markers was monitored on live dashboard, and corrective actions were taken where necessary.




PASSING CRITERIA

A cumulative score of 160 marks out of 400 marks (40%) was set as passing criteria. Success rate of school student was 82%.

REWARD TO TOP THREE POSITON HOLDERS SCHOOLS IN EACH DISTRICT

In order to encourage and motivate in QAT PEIMA authority approved to award cash- prize up to Rs. 75000/- for provision of high quality swings to the top three schools from each district. Subject to provision of vouched accounts and entries in relevant registered.

Licensee of the top three schools of the concerned district were advised to procure high quality swings, slides etc. for students to promote healthy co-curricular activities and to attract the out of school children (OSC) in the school.








SHOW-CAUSE FOR THRICE FAILURE IN QAT

As per approval in 19th Authority Meeting of PEIMA, 72 individual Licensees who failed thrice in Quality Assurance Test were issued show-cause notices for cancellation / Termination. Their Licenses after fulfilment of procedural / coddle formalities were cancelled. Advertisement for these schools for re-allocation was published.

LARGE SCALE ASSESSMENT (LSA) GRADE-4

PEC conducted LSA at the end of academic year in order to assess what the students have learnt in order to determine the remedial strategies to help boost learning. It is a sample based assessments used to determine both the student leaning outcomes as well as documenting other factors that influence SLOs. It is benchmarking of students achievement against national curriculum goals and standards, alignment for comparison of students achievement against peers from sister organizations such as PEF, LNFC, SED, Private Performance of PEIMA Schools and student, were comparable with PEF, LNFB, DPS as is shown below:

TEACHER TRAINING

Teacher Training of Individual licensees of PEIMA has been conducted through Quaid-e-Azam Academy for Educational Development (QAED), Punjab from 04th July 2023 till 05th August 2023.

Objectives are as under:

1. Capacity building of Teachers.
2. Address Weak Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) in three subjects (Science, Mathematics and English).
3. Ensure quality education and effective learning
4. Equipping teachers with modern pedagogical techniques

The Training Module was prepared to focus on teaching. The module was based on Pedagogical, Content Knowledge, and lesson plan to enhance the learning process. Special attention was paid to weak SLOs / capacity building areas based on result analysis of Quality Assurance Test (QAT).

Face to face nine (9) days training workshops in a phased manner (4th July to 5th August) were organized at Tehsil level throughout Punjab. QAEDs Resource persons trained Lead Trainers (LTs) at provincial level, Master Trainers (MTs) at the Division level, and subsequently, these Master Trainers trained 4000 teachers at Tehsil level. The participants were provided stationery and refreshment.

PEIMA chalked out a holistic monitoring mechanism to ensure attendance of teachers, availability of facilities and delivery of content by the Master Trainers. Monitoring of training workshops was made by officers of PEIMA and QAED to ensure effectiveness.

Teachers welcomed the initiatives taken by PEIMA. Participants were more confident and effective in their presentation of various activities related to Mathematics, Science and English. The participants were of the view that such training session should be conducted every year, so that they are better able to cope with the emerging teaching skills.





PEIMA-SCHOOL INFORMATION SYSTEM (SIS-PEIMAN)

Since its establishment, PEIMA had relied on the School Information System developed by the Punjab Education Foundation (PEF). However, due to limited technical resources such as bandwidth and processing capacity, PEIMA was consistently facing challenges in its day-to-day online activities. Licensees also had some reservations during enrolment campaigns. Recognizing the importance of School Information System and the difficulties experienced by PEIMA, PEIMA Authority in its 15th meeting held on 25th May, 2022 approved to develop its own system to create an independent web-based School Information System.

The executable code files of the existing SIS, developed by PEF has been migrated has been migrated, to the hosting space provided by PITB. This transition now allows PEIMA to operate a separate SIS using its own resources.






1. School Login: This login provides access to specific school.

PEIMA also organised in house training sessions on topics related to Office Management from 25th May 2023 till 17th June 2023.



ANTI-DENGUE MEASURES

PEIMA remained committed to enhance health and safety of its schools, students staff and visitors through rigorous anti-dengue measures with a focus on preventive practices.

- Display of Dengue related Banners, Posters & Charts
- Removal of Junks/debris
- Removal of stagnant water

- Ban on wearing of Half Sleeve shirts

A Dengue walk was arranged on 12th July, 2023 to create awareness to avoid outbreak of Dengue.

In order to decrease Dengue dormancy in schools following measures are adopted:

1. Strict compliance on SOPs for Anti-Dengue Activities.
2. Focal Persons have been nominated at district level to assist the licensees of PEIMA schools in order to ensure zero dormancy on daily basis.
3. Special cleanliness campaign is carried out in all PEIMA PSSP schools before opening after summer/winter vacations.
4. In PEIMA penalty framework, 2 to 5% penalty is imposed on the monthly payment of licensees in case of non-compliance on Dengue SOPs accordingly.
5. At district level PEIMA deputed Dengue Focal Persons to attend the meetings arranged by District Administration.

KPK EDUCATION DEPARTMENT VISIT ON 19-22 MARCH.

Officers of KPK Elementary & Secondary Education Department (ESED), Elementary & Secondary Education Foundation (ESEF), Planning & Development Department (P&DD) and Finance Department visited PEIMA Punjab from 19 to 22 March 2023.

Chief Executive Officer, PEIMA and her team, briefed the delegation about PEIMA mandate and operations.



The delegation also visited PEIMA School GGPS Chungi Amer Sidhu, Lahore, on 20th March 2023 being run by NGO.

Since its outsourcing the school's enrolment has increased from 20 to 800. School data is linked to PEIMA and PMIU. The NGO receives PKR 815 per student per month fee inclusive of management fee from PEIMA. This PPPs model looks financially viable from the government's perspective where the risks and costs are shared by both government and the licensee. Any shortfall in funds is managed by NGO from other sources such as Corporate Social Responsibility and philanthropy.

KEY FINDINGS OF THE DELEGATION AS REPORTED IN THEIR NEWSLETTER

The students in different grades were spot assessed for their reading and arithmetic skills. All the students tested showed a remarkable degree of achievement, comparable to that of high cost private schools.

- i. PEIMA is a good example of Government of Punjab's efforts to put in place, solid policy, frameworks for implementing effective PPPs resulting in improved access and learning outcomes, while reducing cost for government.
- ii. The Government of Punjab has successfully tapped social philanthropy, CSR, charity, and donor funding through private/NGO sector to contribute to the government's effort for providing good quality education at low cost.
- iii. PEIMA is managing schools in a phased and targeted manner by prioritizing the most underprivileged and fragile communities to ensure their inclusion in PPPs programs. The M&E system is robust and ensures quality of education and accountability of both public and private partners.


STATUS OF COURT CASES
